### **NORTHAMPTON COUNTY ELIGIBLE FOR FEMA INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE FOLLOWING HURRICANE IRENE**

**(Nazareth, Pennsylvania)** – Northampton County residents and small businesses are now eligible to apply for federal assistance for storm related damages following Hurricane Irene.

The major disaster declaration for Pennsylvania, FEMA-4025-DR, was amended to include Individual Assistance for Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lehigh, Luzerne, Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, Sullivan, and Wyoming Counties.

Northampton County Emergency Management Services Director, Robert Mateff, noted that “without the hard work and assistance from local municipalities and Emergency Management staff, this declaration would not be possible.”
